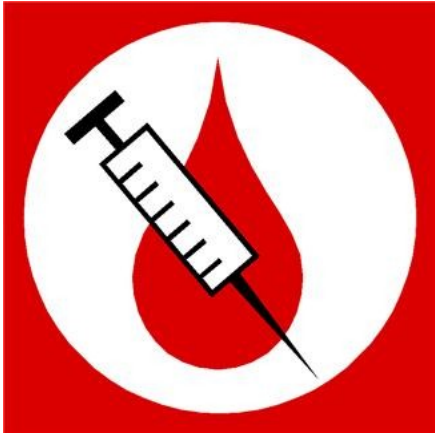


SHARPS DISPOSAL



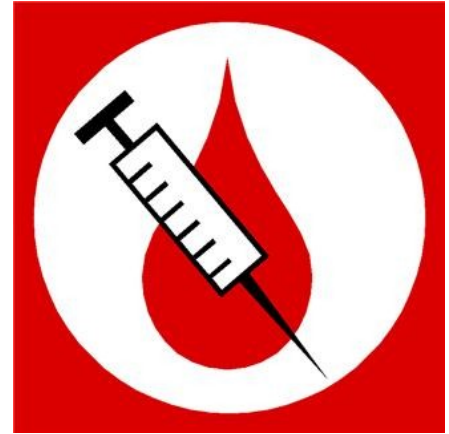
DO NOT RECAP SHARPS

LANCETS (USED TO STICK YOUR FINGER) AND SYRINGES (USED TO INJECT INSULIN) ARE CONSIDERED 'SHARPS'. AFTER THEY ARE USED SHARPS ARE CONSIDERED CONTAMINATED.

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO DISPOSE OF SHARPS PROPERLY SO THAT NO ONE ELSE GETS STUCK WITH THEM. THE PROPER WAY TO DISPOSE OF SHARPS IS AS FOLLOWS:

- PLACE IN A METAL CONTAINER (EX: A COFFEE CAN) OR A HEAVY PLASTIC CONTAINER (EX: DETERGENT BOTTLE), *DO NOT USE A MILK JUG OR A SODA BOTTLE.*
- KEEP LID ON CONTAINER
- KEEP CONTAINER OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
- WHEN CONTAINER IS 3/4 FULL, TAPE LID ON WITH DUCT TAPE TO SECURE. LABEL CONTENTS.
- DISPOSE OF CONTAINER IN REGULAR TRASH.

SHARPS DISPOSAL



DO NOT RECAP SHARPS

LANCETS (USED TO STICK YOUR FINGER) AND SYRINGES (USED TO INJECT INSULIN) ARE CONSIDERED 'SHARPS'. AFTER THEY ARE USED SHARPS ARE CONSIDERED CONTAMINATED.

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO DISPOSE OF SHARPS PROPERLY SO THAT NO ONE ELSE GETS STUCK WITH THEM. THE PROPER WAY TO DISPOSE OF SHARPS IS AS FOLLOWS:

- PLACE IN A METAL CONTAINER (EX: A COFFEE CAN) OR A HEAVY PLASTIC CONTAINER (EX: DETERGENT BOTTLE), *DO NOT USE A MILK JUG OR A SODA BOTTLE.*
- KEEP LID ON CONTAINER
- KEEP CONTAINER OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
- WHEN CONTAINER IS 3/4 FULL, TAPE LID ON WITH DUCT TAPE TO SECURE. LABEL CONTENTS.
- DISPOSE OF CONTAINER IN REGULAR TRASH.
